Germs & attendance...

Our attendance for last week was 96%. As I'm sure you are all aware we have moved into the 'Delay' phase when dealing with Covid-19. There has been lots of speculation regarding school closures; these are not currently planned. We have had no reported cases of parents or children at Ardeley; we continue to follow the Government and Public Health guidelines and receive daily updates.

We have already, as you know, implemented additional hygiene measures including extra handwashing and cleaning. We have planned ahead for possible closures and have made contingency plans to minimise the impact on children's leaning.

The only change to advice for schools is to send home any children (or staff) with a new continuous cough or a high temperature. When sent home, they are to then stay off school for 7 days, however mild their symptoms. This is designed to protect others in your community and is direct government advice. If you or your child are unwell, or have been in contact with anyone suspected of having the virus, please do not visit the school but let us know by telephone. We are reviewing and assessing our events and activities continuously; including swimming, trips and the planned Mothers' Day Tea Party. We will keep in touch with you regarding any changes to these.
